

# Welcome to Grand Falls-Windsor Minor Hockey Association Registration for the 2024-2025 Season!

Please read the following instructions carefully and in full, as it is important that you use the correct link to complete registration for **each** player you are registering, to ensure proper pricing and placement. Depending on your family situation, you may have to use multiple links.

#### **FEE STRUCTURE**

The fee structure this year is as follows:

Coed Regular Season / House League registration:

\$500 for one child

\$450 per child for multi-child families

\$400 for females also registering in Female U15/U18 division

# Female U7-U11 divisions:

We are not taking registration for Female U7, U9, U11 and U13 divisions at this time. Please check out Exploits Female Hockey on Facebook HERE for more information.

# Female U15/18 division:

\$250 (FU15/18 division will be scheduled one ice slot per week, instead of the two slots per week scheduled for coed divisions.)

## Rep Team Tryout Fee:

\$25

#### **REP PROGRAM**

There will be a second, separate registration for Rep Teams, once teams are selected (after Rep Team Tryouts). It is anticipated that Rep Team fees will be \$220. A \$25 Rep Team Tryout Fee must be paid at the time of House League Registration in order to attend the Rep Team tryouts later in October (October 19-20 and October 26-27).

#### HNL FEES

A mandatory fee is imposed by Hockey NL on all players, which covers things such as player insurance and the operating costs of HNL. The HNL Fee has not changed from the 2023-2024 season and will remain at \$81 per player this season.

## HOCKEY CANADA NUMBER (HCN) / RESPECT IN SPORT

If your child is new to GFWMHA but has been registered in minor hockey elsewhere, or already has a HCN, please do not register for a new HCN, use the number they already have.

If your child has never been registered in minor hockey, you will need to generate their Hockey Canada Number before you register them. To do so, use the following link:

# Respect in Sport link

This link will direct you to the Respect in Sport program for parents. It is mandatory that one parent complete this program. If you have older children who have already been registered in minor hockey, it is likely that you or the other parent have already completed Respect in Sport. If this is the case, you will need to add the new player to your profile, so they can be linked to your completion certificate. This will also generate their Hockey Canada number.

Login or Register to Respect in Sport.

Click on "Profile".

Go to the "Profile Information" tab.

Go to the "Child Management" tab and add all applicable players to your profile, if they are not already there. Each child's Hockey Canada Number (Hockey Member ID) can be found on this tab.

If you have not completed the program click on "Program Access" to do so. Any children you have linked to your profile will be linked to your completion certificate.

#### **BIRTH CERTIFICATE / SPORDLE**

A birth certificate (proof of age) is required to be uploaded for every player. This is done through your Spordle account, which you access through the following link (only after completing Respect in Sport and linking your player(s) to your profile):

Click on "Members". You will see the initials of the profiles that are linked to yours along the top left of the window.

Click + to add a player, if they are not already linked.

Click the initials of a player to update their profile information. Go to the "Documents" tab to upload the player's birth certificate.

#### REGISTRATION

Once these steps have been completed, you are all set to register. You will use one of three links. Multiple children can be registered on any given link, but only if they meet the criteria of that link.

# **First Time Skaters Registration**

The Town of Grand Falls-Windsor offers a **First Time Skaters Free Registration Program** which covers the registration fee for a player's first year of minor hockey. Parents are responsible to pay the \$81 HNL fee.

In order to be eligible for the program, a player must be a resident of Grand Falls-Windsor at least four years of age who has never been enrolled in minor hockey or figure skating/CanSkate.

Parents are responsible for completing and returning a program application form (to be distributed in October) and a program survey (to be distributed in January). Failure to do so will result in loss of funding and parents will be responsible for paying applicable registration fees.

If your player is eligible for the First Time Skaters Free Registration Program, please use the following link, no matter which program they are registering for, or if they are a player/goaltender:

#### FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The amount of the funding will automatically be deducted from your total before you reach the payment page. #### **PAYMENT**

The following payment options are available:

### E-transfer:

Payment in full only will be accepted by e-transfer.

Select the "Pay Offline" option and then "Continue Checkout". You will be instructed to print a voucher - this is not necessary. Send e-transfer payment in full to <a href="mailto:gfwmha2021@gmail.com">gfwmha2021@gmail.com</a> with password "hockey". Once your payment is processed by the Registrar, you will receive registration payment confirmation by email. Players will not be allowed to participate in programming until this payment is received as it includes the HNL fee (insurance).

## Credit card:

Credit card payment can be made in full OR by four equal installments. Processing fees will apply.

If you choose to pay by installments, the first installment will be charged to your credit card immediately. The remaining installments will be processed on the 15th of October, November and December of 2024.
